

STCS Summer Math Requirements for Students Entering 3rd grade

There is not a class or workbook requirement unless you have been notified directly by your child's current teacher. While a math workbook is not required, if you're looking for one we would recommend the [Spectrum Paperback Math Book, Grade 2](#). Students will be expected to work on basic math fact fluency (addition, subtraction) over the summer. Students can also practice multiplication facts 0-5 and 10. Students may use an app, online program, flashcards, games, etc. to practice the facts. Also incorporate real world math at home. You can work on measuring when you're cooking or baking, addition/subtraction if you're planning a trip or doing an activity (cost), telling time, counting coins, etc.
